



FP7 Key facts and figures

Applications:

As of 2013/10/25, a total of

- 1.000 eligible proposals were submitted in response to 467 FP7 calls for proposals involving 1.075 applicants from SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN (1,54% of DE and 0,21% of EU-28*)
- requesting EUR 312,43m of EC contribution (1,09% of DE and 0,17% of EU-28*)

Among the NUTS1 regions of Germany (DE), SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN ranks:
- 13th in terms of number of applicants and
- 13th in terms of requested EC contribution


